Current planning status: - The site currently has temporary planning permission for and is operated as a mineral extraction site.	
Landscape and Ecology: - The site is not within or in close proximity to any national nature conservation or landscape designations. The site lies within the Plateau Farmland landscape character type as defined in the draft Breckland Landscape Character Assessment. It is bounded by restored and active mineral land to the north and west and operational land to the east. These sites, together with the proposals site, lie within a wider area of open arable countryside. The allocation would have potential to affect protected species or their habitats and Biodiversity Action Plan Species or their habitats (refer to lists in the evidence base for species identified).	
Highways: - The site is located on the C229 Reed Lane which is an HGV Access Route.
