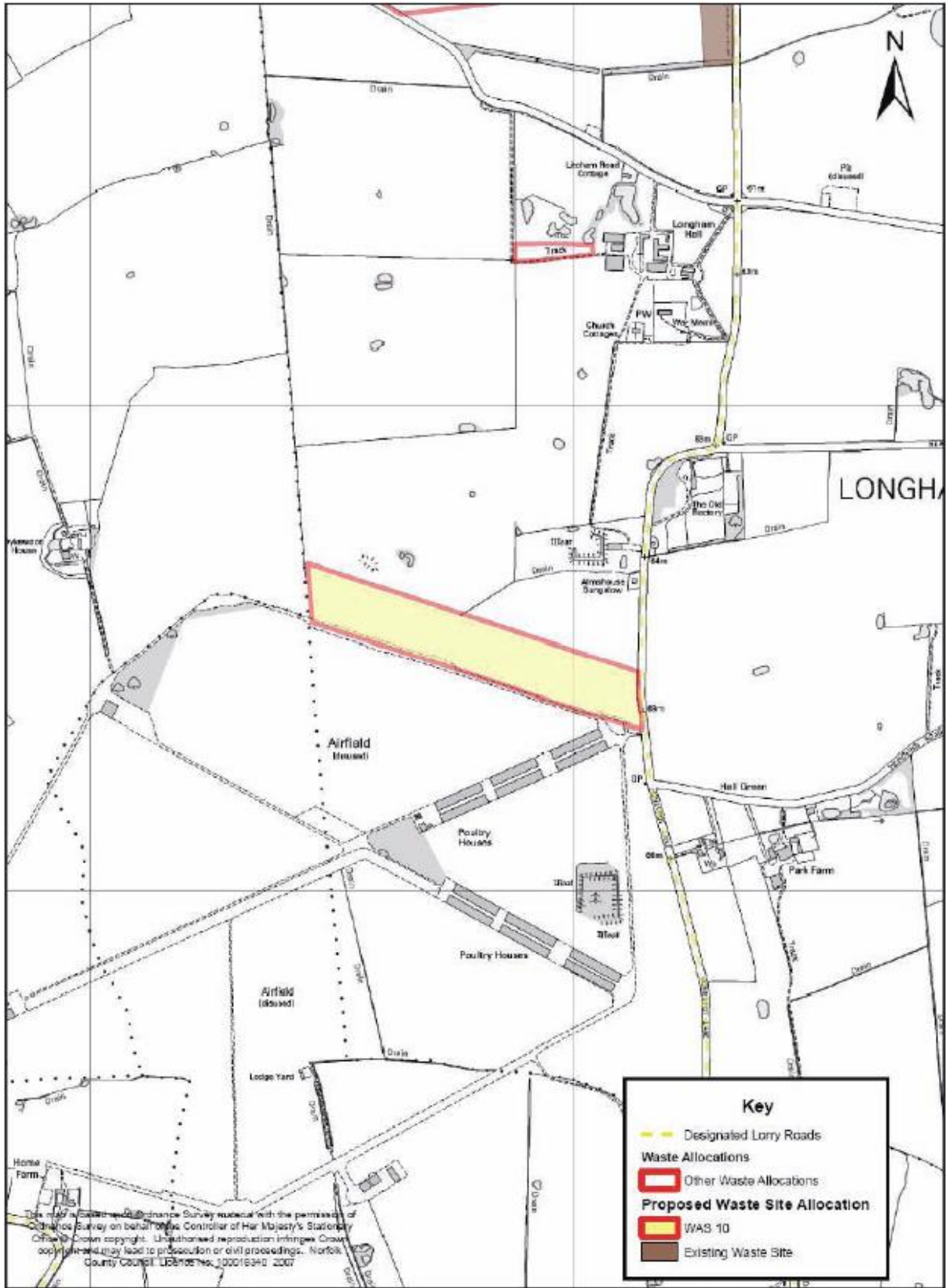

The site lies within the Plateau Farmland landscape character type as defined in the draft Breckland Landscape Character Assessment. The allocation is unlikely to affect protected species or their habitats, or Biodiversity Action Plan species or their habitats.
